

Job Title: DevOps Engineer

Purpose:

Ensuring the reliability and scalability of our current and future infrastructure and application stack. Drive automation and improve deployment processes to streamline software delivery and maintain robust systems in line with ISO and security requirements. Acting as a key enabler for continuous delivery, DevSecOps adoption, and platform reliability, while proactively evolving cloud and on-premise ecosystems to meet changing business needs, emerging technologies, and future operational requirements.

Key Responsibilities:

- **CI/CD Pipeline Development** – Design, implement and maintain automated pipelines for building, testing and deploying applications
 - **Cloud & On-Prem Application Management** – Administer and optimise Azure and on-premises application systems
 - **Monitoring & Logging** – Set up and maintain monitoring solutions across DevOps and Application Software deployed across the business
 - **Security & Compliance** – Implement security best practices across infrastructure and deployment processes. Ensure systems meet compliance requirements
 - **Automation & Tooling** – Develop scripts and tools to automate routine tasks and improve operational efficiency
 - **Collaboration & Support** – Support application lifecycle and troubleshoot deployment issues working closely with Software Development and IT Support
 - **Incident & Request Management** – Response to incidents and requests per the ITIL Framework across the Application/DevOps stack
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Requirements:

- 3+ years in a DevOps role, preferably in a security-focused or highly regulated environment
- Excellent technical knowledge and experience in Azure
- Strong knowledge of CI/CD tools (e.g. Jenkins, GitLab CI, Azure DevOps)
- Ability to design, deploy and manage complex Microsoft-based infrastructure environments
- Knowledge of containerisation and orchestration (Docker, Kubernetes)
- Understanding of networking, security and system administration principles
- Experience with GitOps and modern deployment strategies
- Familiarity with Agile and DevOps methodologies

- Familiarity with scripting languages (e.g. Bash, Python, PowerShell)
 - Excellent troubleshooting, communication and documentation skills
 - Eligible to obtain UK security clearance
